

# Interprofessional Teams (N4I03/HS4I03)

## Course Description

Study types and structures of interprofessional teams in health care organizations. Apply theories and strategies to real teams in the workplace.

The major components of the course include:

- Building effective teams
- Interprofessional team decision-making and conflict
- Interprofessional team performance
- Leadership and interprofessional teams
- Interprofessional teams and emotional intelligence
- Teams and information technology

## Course Objectives

To provide students with:

- An introduction to the types and structure of teams in health care organizations
- An awareness of the internal dynamics impacting teams
- An awareness of the external dynamics impacting teams
- An opportunity to explore and apply team processes within the workplace
- An opportunity to explore and apply principles of leadership in health care teams
- An awareness of the impact that information technology has on teams

## Course Format

Four written assignments and a final project are to be completed over a 6 month period. Assignments are graded through the use of a standard procedure by an assigned educational consultant. This consultant is also available for assistance throughout the course.

Successful completion of all components leads to 3 units of university credit.
